## Trading with a demo account

Your demo account is a training version of your live account which allows you to trade with virtual money and real instruments without risking your own real money.

What are the advantages of a demo account?

- Open instantly and start trading.
- You train on the same online terminal, where live trading is carried out.
- There is a full set of instruments, each of which you can practice trading on.
- You are automatically credited with free virtual money to trade as you wish.
- There is no risk to your own funds.

How to open a demo account:

- Click «Register an account»
- Fill out a simple form (you must be at least 18 years old).
- Log in to Libertex using your demo account details and train at any time.

The free demo account is a safe way to start exploring the financial markets.

## How to fund Libertex trading account

1. Log in to Libertex using your login and password. If you do not have an account simply create one
2. Click «Fund your account»
3. Select funding method and enter the amount, then click «Go to payment»
4. Depending on your bank there may be the need to confirm your payment again
5. Ready! You will receive a notification of the operation result

## What you should know before trading in Libertex

The trading mechanism in Libertex is unique. All the difficult aspects of trading are configured for you inside the trading terminal, eg. you don't have to know financial terms such as spreads and lots to start trading.

To trade with shares, indices or any other instrument you should:

- Open a trading account in Libertex (1-2 minutes)
- Log in to the Libertex web terminal or download the Libertex mobile app
- Select an instrument (eg. EUR/USD) which you want to trade and click «Open trade»
- In the trade window specify the trade amount and multiplier value
- Set limits for profit and losses (if desired)
- Select the instrument direction (BUY = price will go up or SELL = price will go down) and your trade is done.

## What is a multiplier?

A Multiplier is a coefficient used for risk management while trading with different trading instruments. It determines how the trade will change in relation to the financial asset price change. The coefficient can make from 1 to 500.

To increase a potential profit when trading:

— In the trade window «Multiplier» field set the value more than 1 (for example 5). But in this case risks will increase proportionally.

Trading \$1000 with a multiplier of 5, you actually increase your trade amount to \$5000.  $\$1000 \times 5 = \$5000$ .

Important to remember: potential profit and losses on your trade change in proportion to the specified multiplier value.

**At what price are trades in Libertex terminal executed?**

Trades in Libertex terminal are executed at mid price.

A mid price is calculated as average of the current bid (best price of the buyers) and ask (best price of the sellers) prices. However, since some exchange products' prices have minimum price fluxes set by exchanges themselves, our mid-price cannot be the exact average of bid and ask values, so it's rounded to the nearest value allowed.
